Surfing:

Jeffreys Bay is a surfer's dream destination. Experience the thrill of riding the waves at renowned surf breaks like Supertubes, Boneyards, and Point. If you're new to surfing, consider taking lessons from one of the local surf schools to catch your first wave.

Be sure to ask Sean your local host for tips on the best spot.

Best Time to Surf: Jeffreys Bay produces the best right hand surf break in the world. The best surfing waves are found in May – Sept, especially June/July.

But rideable waves are found throughout the year. Almost every beach offers good surfing opportunities, with Supertubes, Point Bach, Magna Tubes, Boneyards, Kitchen Windows & Main Beach each offering unique advantages to be discovered.

Whale & Dolphin watching:

Whales can be seen during the winter and spring months. During this period, southern right whales migrate to the coastal waters of South Africa, including the area around Jeffreys Bay to give birth & nurse their calves. These majestic creatures can often be spotted breaching & tail-slapping. The calves are usually born in Spring and can often be seen frolicking in the ocean.

Dolphins can often be spotted in Jeffreys Bay especially in the early morning or late afternoon.

Shops & Shopping:

Jbay Surf Village: Is a must go to stop for visitors. There is a cluster of surf shops and factory stores has been entertaining visitors since the 80's. The JBay Surf Village is an international melting pot of surf and skate culture, home decor, yummy restaurants and pamper spots. A short walk from blue-flag status, Dolphin Beach, it's an outdoor shopping mall the whole family will want to visit, time and again.

The skatepark is free and allows for visitors of all ages including dad to try the half pipe and some fun rails.

The Green Room: is the ideal place for anyone wanting to study or work on line.

Climate & Weather

Jeffreys Bay, located in South Africa, experiences a mild coastal climate with warm summers and cool winters. Here's an overview of the climate in Jeffreys Bay:

Summer (December to February): Summers in Jeffreys Bay are warm and pleasant, with average daytime temperatures ranging from 20°C (68°F) to 25°C (77°F). It can occasionally get hotter, reaching up to 30°C (86°F) or higher. The nights are generally cool, with temperatures dropping to around 15°C (59°F). This season sees moderate rainfall, and thunderstorms are not uncommon.

Autumn (March to May): Autumn in Jeffreys Bay is characterized by mild and comfortable temperatures. Daytime temperatures range from 18°C (64°F) to 23°C (73°F), while nights become cooler, averaging around 12°C (54°F) to 16°C (61°F). Rainfall decreases during this season, and the weather becomes relatively drier.

Winter (June to August): Winters in Jeffreys Bay are cool and can be somewhat chilly, especially at night. Daytime temperatures average between 16°C (61°F) and 20°C (68°F), while nighttime temperatures can drop to around 7°C (45°F) to 10°C (50°F). Winter is the driest season in terms of rainfall, and it generally experiences less precipitation compared to other seasons.

Spring (September to November): Spring brings mild temperatures and is a transitional season in Jeffreys Bay. Daytime temperatures range from 18°C (64°F) to 23°C (73°F), while nights gradually become milder, averaging between 10°C (50°F) and 15°C (59°F). Rainfall increases as the season progresses, with occasional showers and thunderstorms.

Wind

Windy days are common, especially in Oct – Jan. The beach can be very unpleasant on windy days. The wind often tends to calm down at the end of the afternoon.

Overall, Jeffreys Bay enjoys a temperate climate with relatively mild temperatures throughout the year. It is influenced by its coastal location, with the Indian Ocean playing a role in moderating the temperature extremes. It's always a good idea to check the local weather forecast for the most accurate and up-to-date information before planning your trip or activities. Rain can be expected around 6 days per month.
